U-Abo App – With the U-Abo App from BLT and BVB, you can buy new monthly or annual subscriptions or view and renew existing subscriptions at any time and from any location.



BVB Basel & Regio – The BVB-App provides you with real-time timetable information for the «Triregion» as well as easy access to maps and network plans. By linking it to the BLT «Tickets» App, you can also buy tickets directly from the timetable.



BLT-App «Tickets» – With the «Tickets» App, you can quickly, easily and securely buy TNW single-journey, day and multi-use tickets. In addition, you can use the same App to access the entire Triregion product range.



BLT-App «Departures» – With the «Departures» App, you can call up the current departure times of all public transport services in the TNW network.

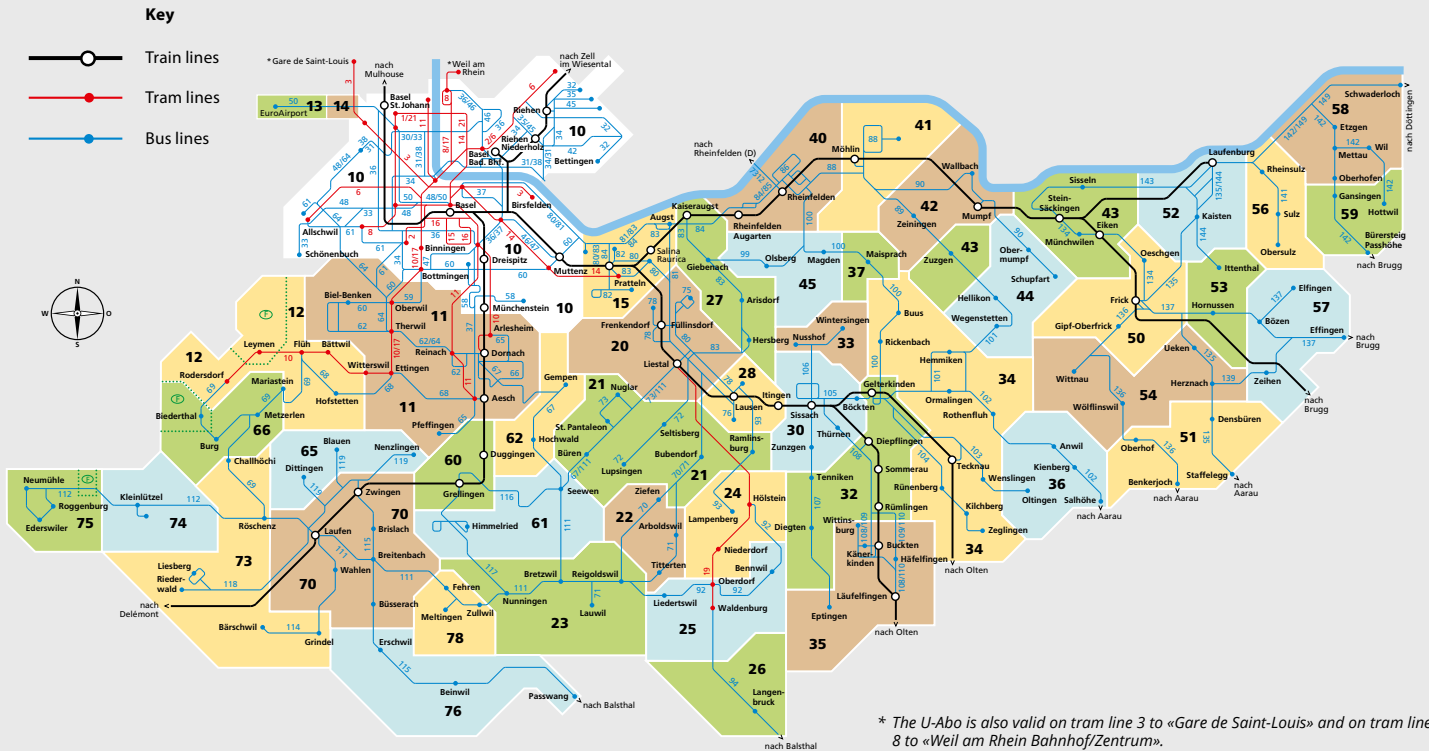
Practical and affordable

You pay just 10 months instead of 12 for an annual U-Abo. The U-Abo Card enables you to purchase your U-Abo quickly and conveniently starting from any date for a month or a year from a ticket machine. SBB ticket machines can be used to renew your U-Abo from any date with your Half Fare Travelcard or SwissPass. And with the U-Abo app, you can purchase your new U-Abo on your smartphone at any time. All prices apply to individuals resident for tax purposes in the network region. Prices may be subject to change.

Valid from 13 December 2021



* The U-Abo is also valid on tram line 3 to «Gare de Saint-Louis» and on tram line 8 to «Weil am Rhein Bahnhof/Zentrum».

TNW tickets are valid until the last stop within the network area when used on SBB trains that travel beyond the limits of the network area. TNW tickets are not valid on scheduled trains that do not stop before leaving the network area.

The U-Abo is recognised or is valid in the RVL border zones 1, 2 and 3 for a two-year trial period. Annual RVL tickets are recognised in TNW zones 10 and 40 (Swiss Rheinfelden). Monthly and annual RVL tickets are valid between the border and Basel-Claraplatz on tram lines 6 and 8 and bus lines 38 and 55, as well as in Swiss Rheinfelden (line 7312).
